need.

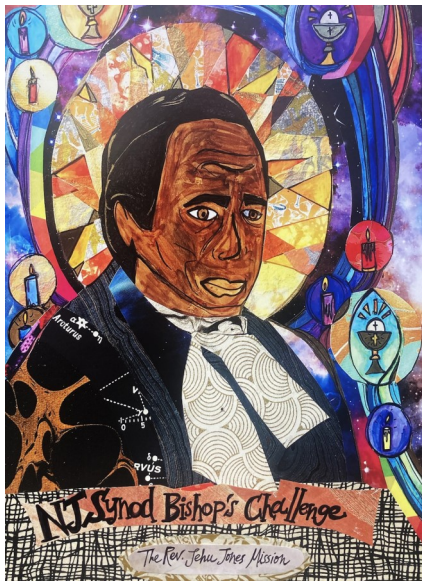
Please bring in the

**Working** to address the racial inequity and injustice in our world.

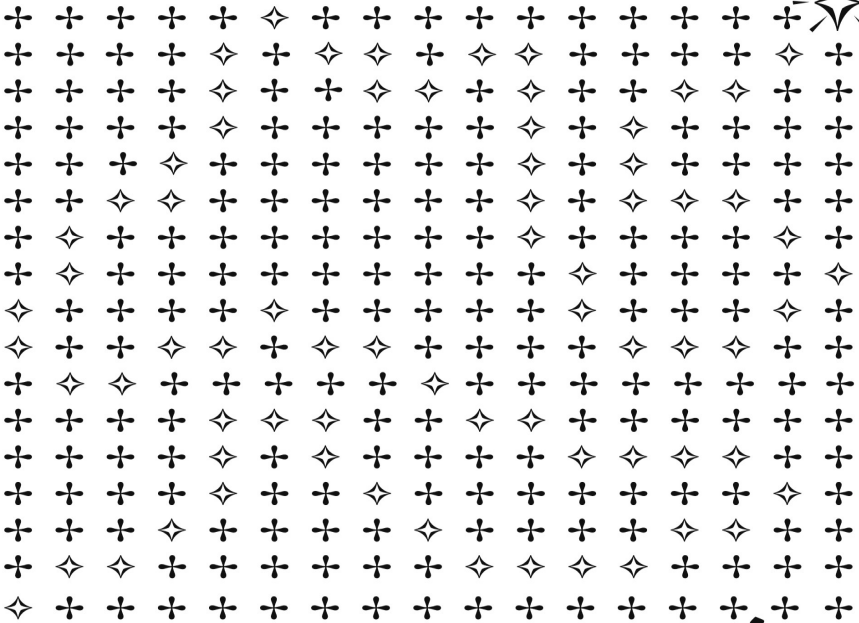
