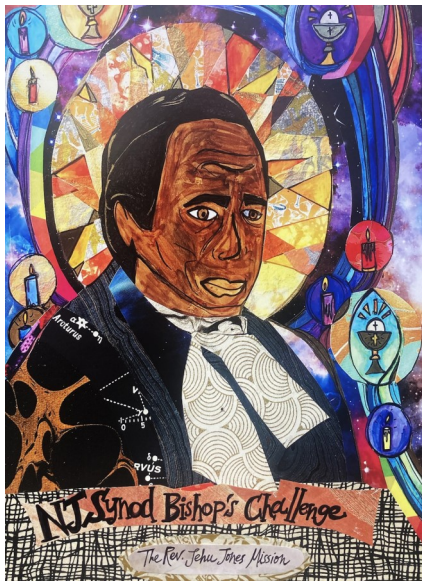
Bills for Change
