and pray that they may be given peace in the midst of all this pain.

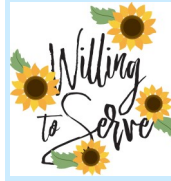

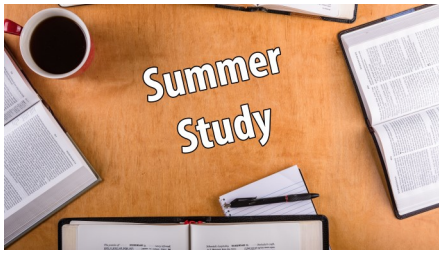
